Kindergarten

Kindergarten students will ease into the school year. Starting with a Popsicle Party Tuesday Sept. 4th from 3-4 PM, families may drop off their school supplies in the classroom on the way to the party in the Science Park. Half of the Kindergarten students come to school on September 6th and the other half will come on September 7th. This allows teachers to build relationships with each child on their first day and introduce students to the routines of school in a small group. All students attend school September 10th! For any families who did not participate in the Kindergarten screening in May your child should be scheduled for a screening appointment on Wednesday, September 5th at 9:15 AM. Arrival and dismissal procedures have changed please see Dr. Safier's letter and the enclosed transportation letter from me for details. Having students take the bus to and from school is highly recommended. It is very important that you make every effort to have your child arrive at school before 8:50 as this is the time when we will be bringing students to their classrooms. **If you arrive at or later than 9:00 you will need to park and bring your child into the school building to sign them in.** Please note that there is no parking in the school parking lot during arrival and dismissal.
